The author is not mentioned outside this book which bears his name. Date of Writing. Hosea began his ministry in the reign of Israel's king Jeroboam II (793-753 B.C.) and continued into the reign of Hezekiah (728-686 B.C.). Since the fall of Samaria is not mentioned as an accomplished fact, the prophecy was probably recorded around 725 B.C. Historical Setting. Hosea began his prophetic ministry in Israel during the prosperous reign of Jeroboam II.
